- Jesus invites these fishermen to be part of his team, to bring his message of happiness to others.
- They learned from their Master how to live in a way that is pleasing to God and to others. They learned to pray to God without fear, calling him Father, as He called him. They also learned to give thanks for the gift of Creation and the care that God has of everything he has created, such as the little birds and the flowers of the field.

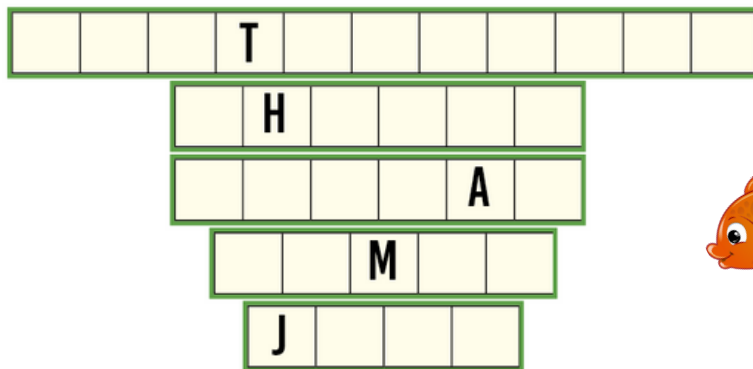
